

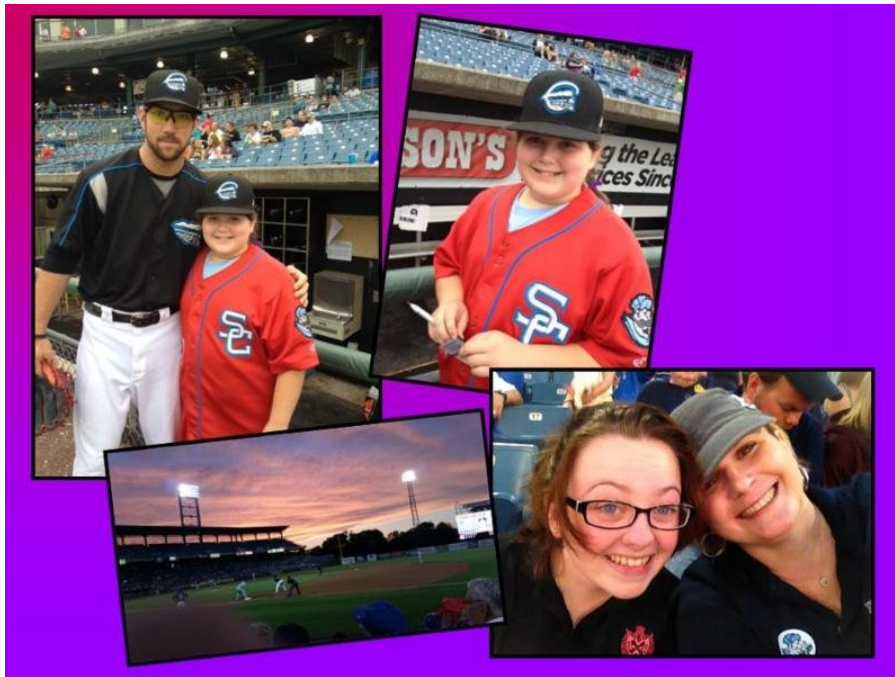

together!

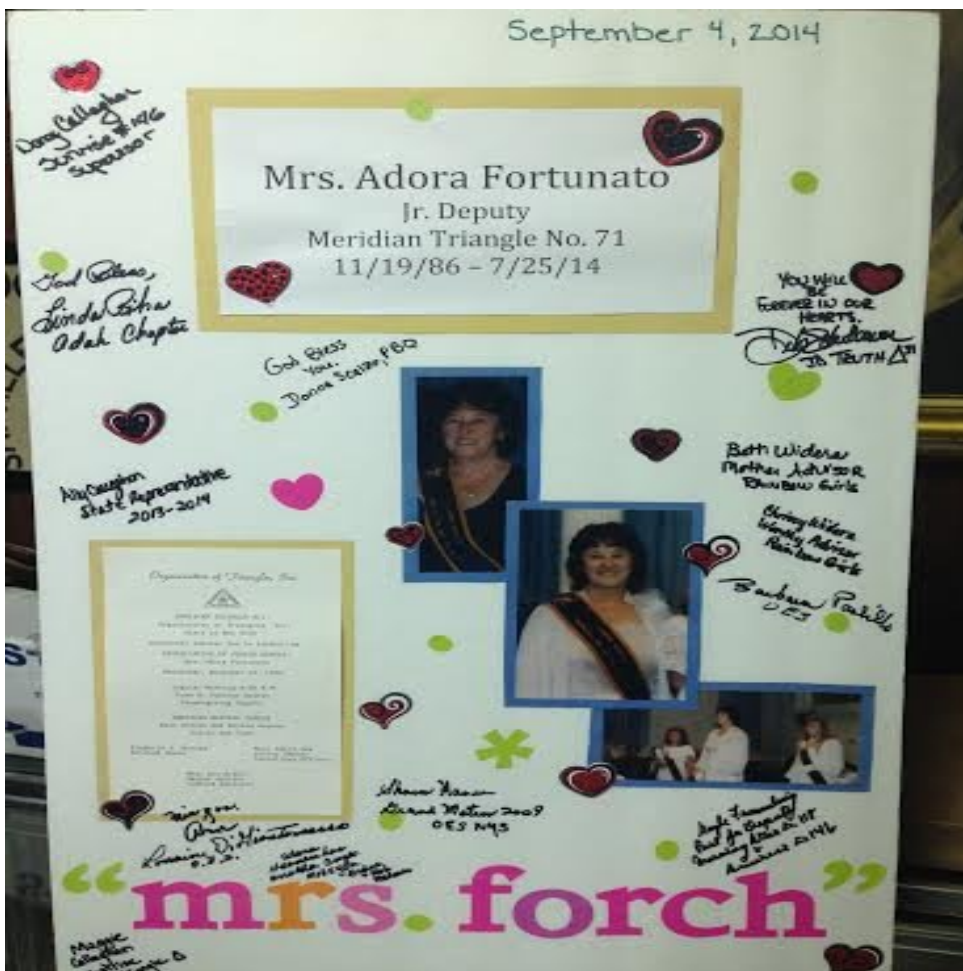
