


Triangle at the Falls! Niagara Falls, NY

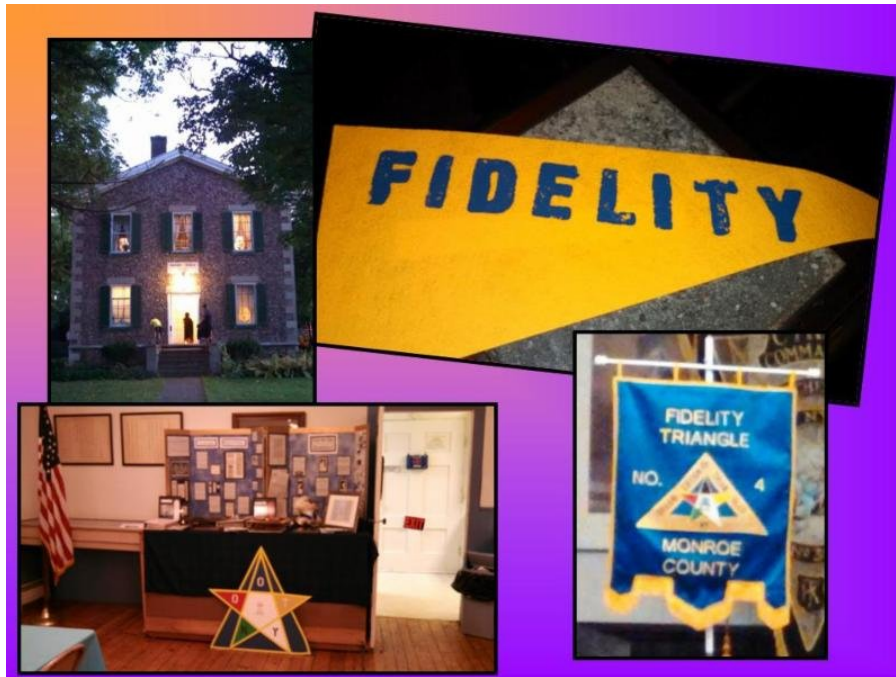

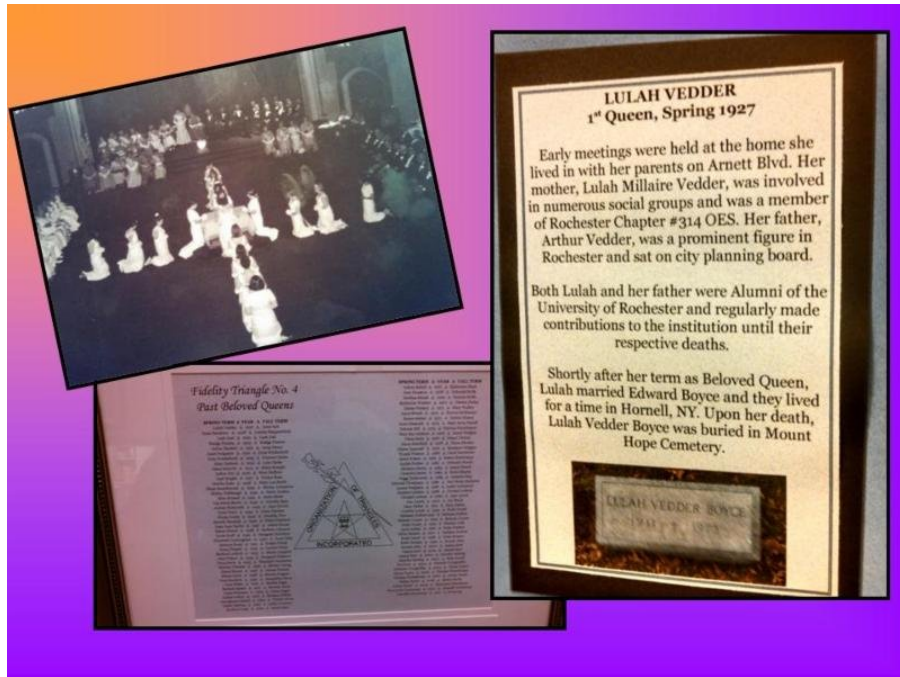

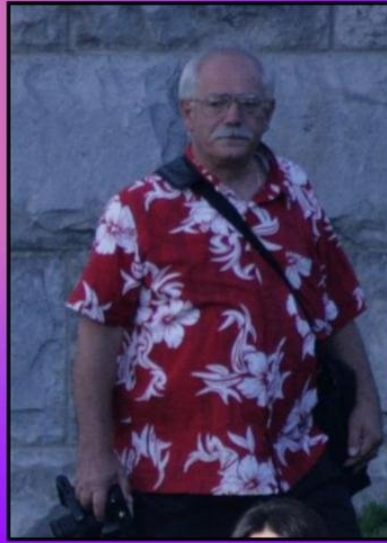
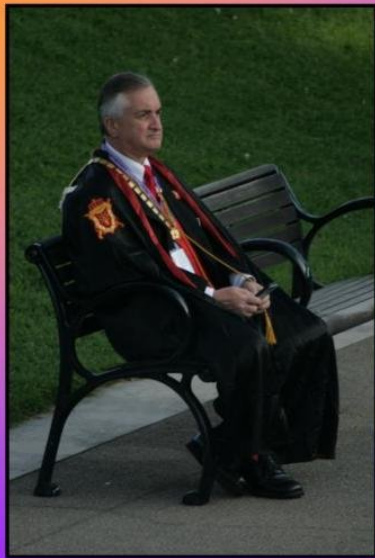
