



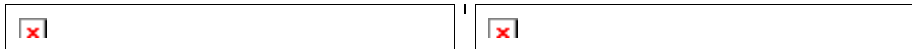


**Our Founder...

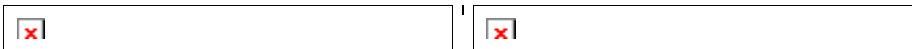

Meridian Triangle #71 celebrated Halloween on October 30th with a festive party! Looks like all of the goblins, ghouls, and...pastors? had a blast!

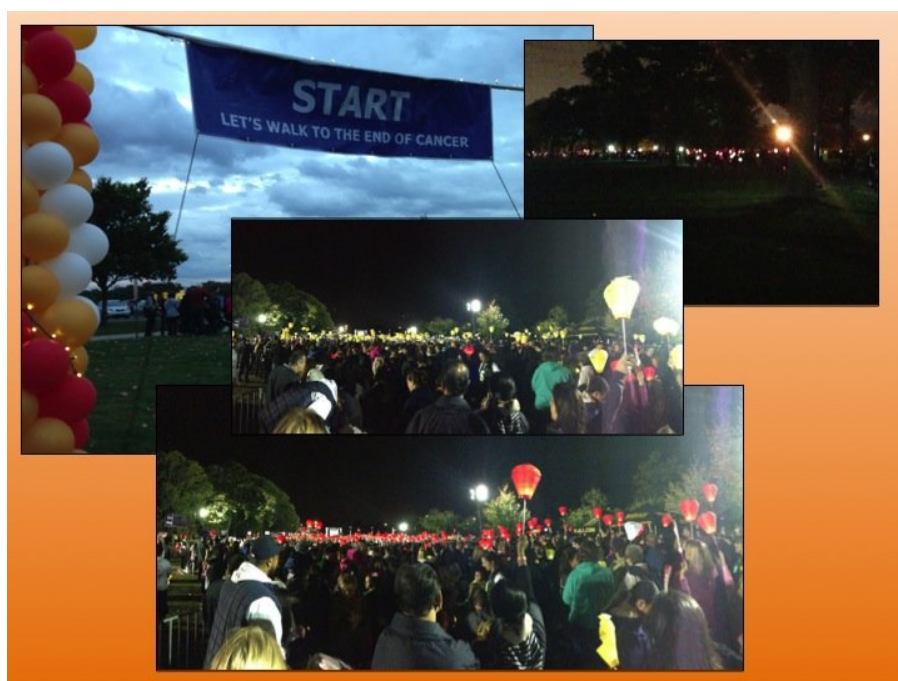

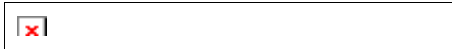
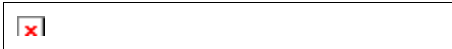
Fidelity Triangle has a boo-tiful

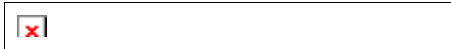
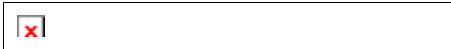
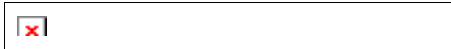
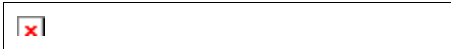
With a few petitions handed out during the event Fidelity Triangle looks forward to seeing growth within the next year.

## Onistagrawa Triangle Celebrates Halloween & Prospective Members! Scotia, NY

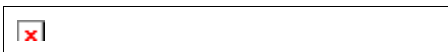
Onistagrawa Triangle #215 held an open meeting on Sunday, October 26th where

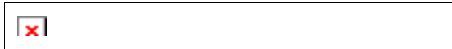
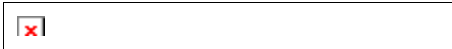


they welcomed two potential new members.
